ENGL 4482: Popular Culture Photographing "London"

This section of ENGL 4482 Popular Culture is a digital photography course, primarily. It will combine the theoretical study of popular British culture with the basics of photography in order to examine images or representations of cultural London, like politics, art, cuisine, and other aspects of London. We will address notions of visual rhetoric, photographic representations of "London" and "England," and the image as a reflection and determiner of "reality."

ENGL 4482: Popular CultureCourse Requirements

Daily Photo Blog (40%)

Each day, you should record your experiences about London through your photography. Your blog should contain your thoughts and analysis about London culture, art, architecture, food, multi-culturalism, and life. You should include not only photos and writing, but other multimedia from your wanderings.

Exam (20%)

A cumulative final essay exam will be given that covers readings, vocabulary, discussions, and field trips.

Wiki Contribution (20%)

You will be contributing at least one article to the course wiki. Consider the wiki like a class newsletter about London, and you are a reporter that needs to research and write a specific article that highlights a particular aspect of our classes' study of London.

Participation (20%)

All classroom activities that are not defined above count toward class participation, like quizzes, viewing a film, etc. "You find no man, at all intellectual, who is willing to leave London.
